## Board Approves ‘Hire Local for High Speed Rail’

Fresno, CA – Today the Fresno County Board of Supervisors passed a resolution to encourage the California High Speed Rail Authority to hire local businesses and local workers to complete its historic first phase of construction that will run through the heart of Fresno County.

Fresno County Supervisor Henry Perea, Fresno Works co-chair, asked the Board to pass the Hire Local for High Speed Rail resolution

“Fresno County boasts a strong, intelligent, able, dedicated and talented workforce,” said Supervisor Perea. “Our residents are eager to get back to work and will do a superior job in the completion of the Authority’s high speed rail line.”

The federal government allotted \$4.3 billion for the Authority to spend on the first phase of its high speed rail line in the San Joaquin Valley. That money would be well-spent to help slash Fresno County’s unemployment rate of 15.2 percent.

The resolution asks the Authority to give a strong commitment to hiring local Fresno County businesses to complete the environmental, planning, design, engineering, and construction work that will be required to complete the first segment of its high speed rail line.
