NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Fresno Council of Governments hereby requests that the California High- Speed Rail Authority give a strong commitment to hiring local Fresno County businesses to complete the environmental, planning, design, engineering and construction work that will be required to complete the first segment of its high-speed rail line.
